

Addendum to the 25-26 Cristo Rey Student and Family Handbook

Cristo Rey is a cellphone free school!

Cellular phones, wearable technology, and smart devices are not conducive to a focused learning environment. Students are expected to put their phones in their assigned cell phone locker each day when they arrive to school. Students in classes will keep their phones in their cell phone lockers throughout the school day and when they are staying for office hours. Students leaving for work will retrieve their phones immediately before exiting the building.

Only students who are working or seniors that have earned open lunch and plan to leave our extended campus will be permitted to retrieve their cell phone from the cell phone locker within school hours. Upon returning to the building, students will be required to return their phones to their cell phone lockers for the remainder of the school day.

Students are expected to know their code for their cell phone locker and to keep that code private. Cristo Rey Columbus is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Students are not permitted to wear or have any other personal electronic devices with them throughout the school day. This means smart watches, tablets, iPads, portable gaming systems, etc. must be turned off and out of sight throughout the school day.

If a cell phone or other unapproved technology is seen in use, teachers/staff will confiscate the device and turn it into the Dean of Students, who may issue further disciplinary consequences.

Students are only permitted to use earbuds/headphones in class with explicit permission from their teacher. Earbuds/headphones are not allowed in the hallways. If students are seen using earbuds/headphones in the hallway, teachers/staff will confiscate them and turn it into the Dean of Students, who may issue further disciplinary consequences.
